CONCLUSIONS	<p>School Update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Custodian Federico retired in April. His replacement Cecilia "Cece" recently started. She is a transfer from Morgan/Maxwell. *Current vacancies: campus monitor, teacher assistant & teacher. *In the process of hiring an Ex-Ed teacher/assistant for the self-contained Cross-Cat classroom transfer also from Morgan/Maxwell. *Shade structure for the parent pick up area was installed this week as planned. *Proposal for 6 more shade structures (2 in Kinder Playground & 4 in playground) has been sent & awaiting approval/installation TBA. *Quote was sent for cement pads, outside tables, outdoor learning labs for the playground. *Field Day is set for Friday, May 20th. Wilson purchased corn hole sets, limbo sets & hurdles for the event. *TUSD is changing the hand sanitizer dispensers, paper towel dispensers & toilet paper dispensers from Granger to Hilliard products this summer. *Teacher Appreciation Week is the first week in May. *Bonus money for teacher should be on the next paycheck. *Final meeting for Rumsley as Facilitator. Pierce has tentatively taken over the position for next school year. <p>Family Engagement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Summer School is being offered at all TUSD schools in June, from 8am to 12pm, Monday-Thursday, with breakfast & lunch provided as well as transportation. Art & Science will be included too. *Promotion Ceremonies back on. Pre-school will have theirs a week before the last day; 5th grade set on the 26th at 9am & Kinder at 1pm that day too. Limit family members 2-3 per student. *PTO Meetings has been rescheduled for Thursday, May 12th. *Wilson has asked PTO to set up another fundraiser night at Peter Piper Pizza soon! *Van Ravanswaay asked where the money goes from the fundraisers. Most monies were spent to purchase Tolson t-shirts for sale. According to Wilson not a lot of monies is left. DISCUSSION	<p>Multiple updates Capital projects purchased through ESSER funds</p> <p>Pads poured, tables ordered, waiting to be delivered Shade structures purchased, money cleared, install date pushed back, possibly Oct 2022 of install of 6 more shade structures on playground. Playground center for PreK and Kinder area, funds were cleared and equipment ordered. Looking at fall of 2022 install. New cafeteria tables, same style, folding into benches, 10-15 years old, no estimated delivery date.</p> <p>New hires: Fully staffed, 2T/a's transferred in EX ED, we hired one TA, Our self-contained classes are fully staffed. Funded TA's for the building, 2 days ago all TA positions are filled, Kinder numbers are high, almost 60 kids. District has given 3rd Full Time Employee (FTE) for a 3rd Kinder class. 2 ways to fill: District assesses numbers and determines if more staff needed. Transfer process, someone was considering Tolson or Johnson, Wilson is assuming the teacher chose Johnson. Another method, traditional hire, and interview candidates. At this point of the year, it is luck to hire someone for the 3rd Kinder class.</p> <p>A teacher on Maternity leave, 3 first grade, 2 classes absorbed all the kids from the 3rd class. When the LOA teacher returns, which may be November, Wilson might make her the 3rd Kinder teacher. The district has provided a 4-hour Teaching Assistant for each Kinder class, that is posted, not filled.</p> <p>Self-Contained Teacher transferred from Morgan Maxwell, Andrina Soto; 3rd Grade Deb Soto returned as a retiree teacher.</p>
